

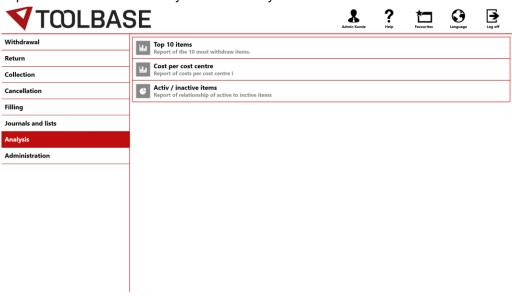

ATMS CORE 1.5.5 changes

The new release of the ATMS CORE software was developed in February 2021. The following functions have been provided in the software for the various innovations, further development and bug fixing:

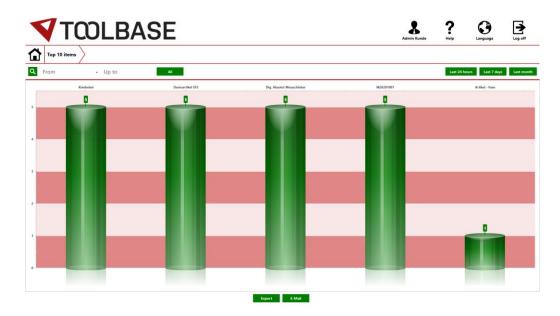
Innovation:

• Implementation of 3 new analyses in the analysis area.



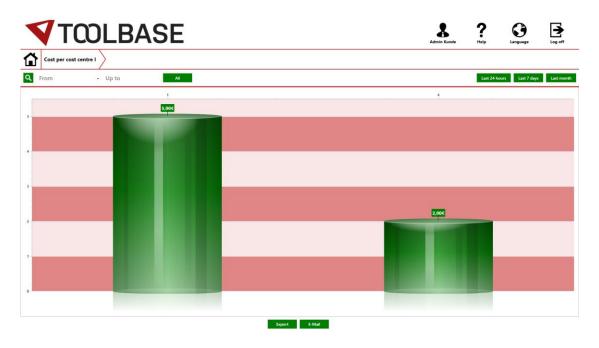
Analysis of the top 10 items:

Display of the withdrawal quantities of the 10 most frequently withdrawn items over a selected period.



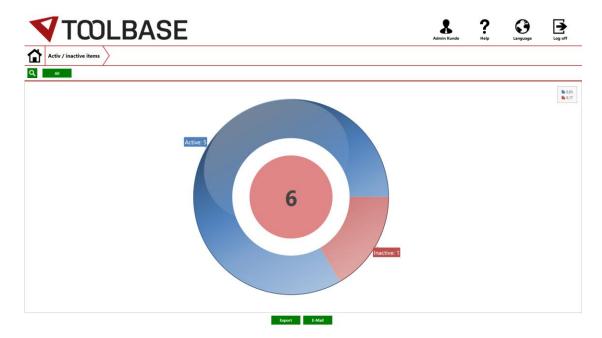
Analysis of costs per cost centre:

Display of the costs per cost centre over a selected period:



Analysis of active / inactive items:

• Expansion of the ATMS LEAN software module with the display of product subgroups.

View of the selection of one of 3 subgroups in the selected main group above:



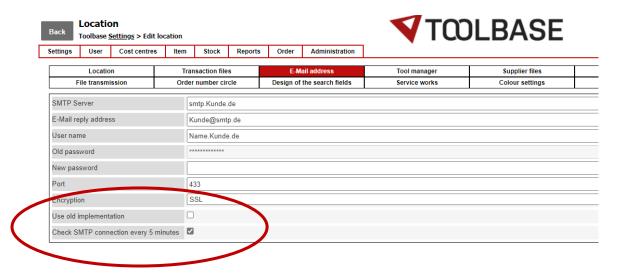


Further development:

• Implementation of an activity check for sending e-mails. Every 5 minutes it is checked whether the stored SMTP server can be reached. If not, an informative error message will be displayed on the home page of the software. This allows the user to react to problems at an early stage.

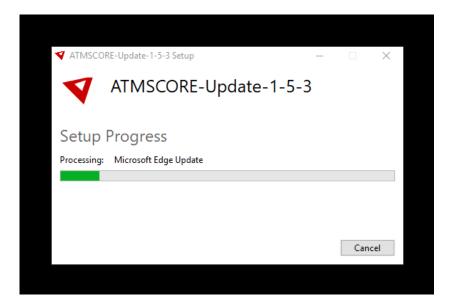


The check can be activated in the e-mail settings in the location.





 Conversion of the browser controls for ATMS CORE Net from Microsoft Internet Explorer 11 to Microsoft Edge. The Microsoft Edge browser is automatically installed as a runtime version during the update process. Internet access may be required to download the installation package in order to carry out the installation.

Bug fixing:

- Fixed the problem where incorrect imports / exports of customer data were not correctly entered in the log files.
- Fixed the problem where the standard path for the database backup in the location was not set correctly and as a result no backup could be created before the customer data import.
- Fixed the problem of incorrect display of the file path selection under the Microsoft Edge browser in ATMS CORE Net.
- Fixed the problem of various labelling and translation errors in the software interface.
- Fixed the problem that when searching in the item selection the search entry was discarded again and thus had no result.
- Fixed the problem that the inventory control could be ended without first closing an open storage location.
- Fixed the problem where the assignment of an item to a parts list via the item master management was not possible and led to a database error message.
- Fixed the problem where items that were not linked in ATMS LEAN were displayed in a product group if these item had been assigned to this product group at some point.
- Fixed the problem where the clients in the location could not be deleted.
- Fixed the problem where items were displayed in a location because they were not assigned.
- Fixed the problem where the processes in ATMS LEAN were not hidden according to the user group setting.
- Fixed the problem where analyses were displayed in the ATMS CORE NET. The analysis area in the ATMS CORE NET has now been removed.
- Fixed the problem that location-based imports did not work.
- Fixed the problem that it was possible to jump briefly from the removal process back to the item list due to an error in the bread crumb navigation, although this was not yet fully completed. This then resulted in the software hanging up in the login screen.
